THE MARRIAGE SERVICE (Statutory fee)

LOCALLY SET FEES

These fees are paid to local staff who assist at your wedding

Organist/use of organ

We have a professional organist to play for all our weddings. These fees are in accordance with the Royal School of Church Music, please see note about video

Verger

The verger prepares the church for your service and is on hand to help when guests arrive and tidies the church after your wedding.
